Welcome to the official website of the **Visit Fukuoka 2025 Campaign!**

Located just across the water from Honshu Island, at the northern tip of Kyushu Island, Fukuoka is the "gateway to Kyushu." Fukuoka is also a meeting point of cultures, as it is almost twice as close to Seoul, South Korea (550km) as it is to Tokyo (1,000km.)

In June 2024, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) announced that it would create the Olympic Esports Games, which will first be held in 2025 in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The games will be an international competition that involves only virtual sports and video games. The Esports Games will include three different versions of video games. There will be virtual sports such as e-cycling, which need much physical activity and are close to traditional sports. There will also be two types of video games: sports simulation games (like NBA 2K) and traditional e-games, or non-sports video games.

The arrival of the Olympic Esports Games does not mean that future video game competitions will take place alongside sports competitions like athletics and gymnastics at the regular Olympic Games. Instead, the games will be a totally separate event. The main reason for keeping the esports games separate from the regular games is that holding them together would simply be too big an event for most countries to manage.

Including competitive gaming into the Olympics has raised other difficult questions too. Many of the top esports titles are violent first-person shooters, which goes against Olympic values of peaceful competition. The IOC stated a year ago that games from the Counter-Strike and Call of Duty series would never be included in Olympic Esports. There is also the issue of gender representation. The regular Paris Olympics in 2024 were the first Olympics ever to achieve “gender parity,” meaning that women athletes had as many places in the Games as male athletes. In contrast, at the League of Legends World Championship in 2022, more than 100 professional players participated, but not even one was female.

The extreme gender imbalance among esports professionals is a mystery. While it is true that the majority of players are male, up to 20% are female. Additionally, unlike more traditional sports, such as soccer or basketball, physical strength and athletic ability are not as necessary for good performances in esports.

Ever since the first days of the internet and social media, photos and videos of cats have been very common content. Recently, as technology has advanced more rapidly, pet lovers have moved from posting photos and videos of real cats to generating them with artificial intelligence instead. The wide availability of free-to-use AI generators has changed the look and feel of the internet. One new trend is videos of AI-generated cats involved in deeply sad situations. Examples are the cats being homeless and begging for food, or being bullied at school.

The AI cat stories do not try to hide the fact that they are made using AI. YouTube and TikTok require creators to clearly state when their content was generated using AI. The fact that the videos are AI-generated does not seem to stand in the way of the audience's emotions. More important than the method of generation seems to be the fact that cats are involved. Many successful creators have chosen to use cats. "I saw that AI-generated content was quite popular," says the creator behind the popular @mpminds account, "I experimented with different ideas before the cat videos, and it was the cat videos that really took off." Professor Jessica Maddox, an author on the topic, says cat content is popular because creators can make cat images mean whatever they want. Furthermore, sad videos are more popular because they trigger the compassion of viewers.

Popular artistic content can be big business. Creators can choose an option to make money off the platforms. They can also direct viewers to external links and services. But is it real art? There are various opinions on this topic, but one thing is clear: the AI machines cannot do everything and still require some creative input from real people. It's up to creators to come up with ideas and themes. Therefore, it is certain that the artist generating the AI content has a significant impact on the outcome.
